


ERRATUM

ERRATUM

The Epicopeiidae: phylogeny and a redefinition, with the description of new taxa (Lepidoptera: Drepanoidea). *Annales de la Société entomologique de France*, 38 (4) : 463-487.

A few misprints should be rectified in my recently published paper (J. Minet 2003) about the Epicopeiidae, a small Asian family now composed of nine genera.

On page 465 (*oculo-facial index*), the colon before "interocular distance" corresponds to a ratio. Then a space should have been left between this colon and "vertical eye diameter".

In the legend to figs. 30-31, the dash following "28" and the two signs following "29" must be replaced, respectively, by a short wavy line and an asterisk.

In the bibliographical list, after "HERING M. 1932" (p. 486), "FORBES W.T.M." and "HESSEL J.H." have been mistakenly substituted for, respectively, "HESSEL J.H." and "HOLLOWAY J.D.". Actually the four references between "HERING M." and "INOUE H." should read as follows:
